CONSTRUCTION INDUSTRY RESPONSE TO COVID-19 FOCUSES ON NEW YORK, NEW JERSEY AND CALIFORNIA. THIS IS A CHECKLIST AND YOU SHOULD CONSULT WITH YOUR ATTORNEY ON ANY SPECIFIC CASE.

COVID-19 WORKPLACE EXPOSURE - Owners – Contractors And Subcontractors Are Required To Provide A Safe Place To Work For Employees.

Protect Against Worker Claims That he/she Contracted Covid-19 Due To Unsafe Workplace Practices.

- Testing workers on entry to a site is a practice which may protect against having allowed an infected worker on site.
- An easy test is taking temperature with a thermometer pressed against the temple.
- Practice social distancing on worksites.
- Provide personal protective equipment (PPE) where close contact is anticipated.
- Where possible stagger trades and/or crews to limit crowding.
